Order of Presentation:

Seminar 1 Called to be a New Testament Watchman

Lays the groundwork for the seminar

Includes God's call to Jane and Aglow for Israel

Seminar 2 God's Everlasting Covenant

Seminars 3-6 may be presented in any order; the two longest are *Media Myths and Misconceptions* and *How to Pray for Arabs, Christians and Jews*

Basic Overview and Information:

- Compiling all the notes, PowerPoint slides, video clips, and video clip scripts with the manual will provide a self-explanatory guide for Presenters.
 - The video clips must be reformatted into the appropriate PowerPoint slides as it is not automatically imbedded.
- The English version is the most recent updated version.
- Jokes only are inserted at the beginning on the 2nd, 4th and 6th workshops. It comes during a break and helps prevent the atmosphere from getting too heavy.
 - Since some jokes might not be humorous in certain countries, Presenters should be free to download any "Yiddish" jokes off of the internet sites.
- Attendance at all 6 seminars is required.
 - o Be certain to send to the global office the names of everyone who completes all 6 workshops in order to be commissioned in Israel as *Watchmen on the Wall*.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Can Presenters teach the different seminars over several weeks or months? *Certainly, as long as all the material is covered. Only then can someone be commissioned.*

How do Presenters get the manual (or is it downloadable from the website)? *The manual is downloadable from the web (copies for all translations are available).*

How much should Presenters charge for the course? *Each Presenter can set his or her own registration fee.*

Do Presenters keep some of the registration fees (to pay their expenses)?

Each Presenter can use the registration fees to cover all expenses including compensation for training services.

Should Presenters send some percentage of the fees to headquarters?

After all expenses are covered, about 25% would be a good contribution to headquarters.

How do Presenters register the names of those who have finished the course?

Everyone who completes the 6 workshops should have their names and complete contact information sent to the global office by the National Leader or Presenter to input into the WOW distribution list.

Are any extra readings required for satellite students?

No extra reading is required.

Are there other "perks" for those who complete the course; for example, being on a mailing list for updates, a prayer list?

They're invited to send names in for the Monday night prayer conference call. Even if they cannot get on the call, the prayer report is sent via email
