



Praying for Muslim Children

Approximately half of the Muslims of the world are under the age of 15 years!

Every Muslim is unique and wonderful in God's eyes. Christians need be to careful not to generalize or presume that all Muslims are the same.

1. Because Muslim families think that Christian children (especially western children) are ungodly, they need to see the Gospel lived out before them. Our godly children have a wonderful opportunity to break this mindset and the judgments against American Christian children.

PRAY that children from Christian families will be a good witness of the love of Jesus.

2. Many of the mosques in this nation have elements of radical Islam gaining a stronger voice. A reliable report disclosed that 80% of mosques in the U.S. adhere to an extreme form of Islam known as Wahhabism.

PRAY that Muslim children will not be influenced by this increased radicalism, but rather turn from it.

3. Our children cannot be kept in a sealed off environment, (sorry, Moms!) They are relating and interacting with Muslim children in school, in after school activities, and increasingly in our neighborhoods. In Middle Eastern culture, people are often very hospitable. Increasingly, our children will develop friendships with Muslim children.

PRAY that our Christian children will not be confused, influenced and persuaded as they interact.

4. Even in our rural areas we are seeing more and more Muslim families moving into small communities. This will be an opportunity for Christian families to be an actual living demonstration of the love of Christ.

PRAY that Christian families will not be fearful, but rather demonstrate the love of Jesus to their Muslim neighbors. Ask the Lord to show Christian families how to reach out and develop relationships with Muslim children.

5. Islam is a fear based religion. Muslims are taught that their god, Allah holds himself apart from mankind. They believe that Allah is unknowable and for this reason it is impossible to ever have a personal relationship with him or know him as savior. Obedience and submission to this false belief are at the foundation of their faith. In Islam there is no plan of redemption for sin.

PRAY that Muslim children will have dreams and visions of Jesus, be convicted of sin and receive a revelation of Him as the Son of the living God.

6. Many Muslim children in restricted nations have never had an opportunity to personally meet a Christian.

PRAY for the hearts of Muslim children to be open to hear the truth and for Christians to come into their lives and boldly yet lovingly share the gospel.

7. A Christian website reporting on outreach to Muslims said that Christian nannies, hired by Muslim families, have a wonderful opportunity to affect the lives of the children.

PRAY that the living witness of the nannies will produce lasting, godly fruit in the lives of the children in their charge.

God has given us as believers the authority in prayer "to move mountains," set captives free and rewrite history! YOU ARE A HISTORY MAKER!
