SUGGESTIONS FOR PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS OF THE MANDATES FOR AGLOW LIGHTHOUSES AND GROUPS

Have a 5-7 m inute M and ate Spot at each Lighthouse m eeting.

- O Head line Report: Share something from the new spaper, magazine, etc., related to one or more of the mandates, then pray about it.
- Share an interesting fact about the mandate (ie, the number of Muslim nations in the
 world, the largest Muslim nation, the original boundaries of the Promised Land given by
 God vs. the current national boundaries of Israel, etc.)
- Share current statistics or trends and pray about them together (ie, influx of Muslims into Western nations, etc.)
- Have someone research what is happening in the community or city and bring a brief report to the meeting. Pray.

Have prayer groups or Triple Cord prayer that focus on the mandates, one of them, or all three. Hold a special meeting and invite pastors and their wives, church Directors of Education, w om en's m in istry leader, and other leaders in the church/com m unity to share w ith them information about the mandates. Would need to show how the mandates are of concern to all Christians

Encourage the women to become informed by reading books related to the mandates, and bringing a brief book report at the Lighthouse meeting.

Form book clubs to read, discuss, and share some of the books on the resource list.

A fter sharing about one of the m and ates, use the Fun Q uiz at the end of this guide as a light-hearted way of closing your teaching time.

MALE/FEMALE (see also Practical Application for M/F Mandate)

Plan a special meeting and/or seminar for couples, with an Aglow speaker that can share on the Male/Female Mandate.

ISLAM (see also Practical Application for Islam Mandate)

Show a *Diwaniya* video at the Lighthouse meeting (contact Diane Moder, Islamic Education & Awareness Director).

Invite a Muslim Christian woman to share her testimony.

Select one of the remaining nations that are in the 10/40 Window and make it a target of prayer; give a 2-minute talk at the Lighthouse about the culture and status of women.

ISRAEL (see also Practical Application for Israel Mandate)

Celebrate certain feasts with a Jewish dish, recipe, tradition, or dance at a Lighthouse meeting or prayer group.

Make a connection with a local synagogue or Rabbi with the idea of dialoguing about Israel, having him share at a meeting, and/or sharing with him the vision God has given Aglow.

MALE-FEMALE RECONCILIATION MANDATE SUGGESTED PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS

Jane's book, *Fashioned for Intimacy*, is in the process of being revised and republished. When it is released, obtain a copy and be available to share the message of the book.

Fast and pray for the men in our lives and sphere of influence. Enlarge our scope to pray for the men in the world to fulfill their destiny. Continue to pray and be a part of the restoration of women through the Aglow ministry, which ultimately brings wholeness to marriages, families and the body of Christ.

Look for speakers that would clearly reflect this message to speak at our Local Aglows.

Present a "workshop" to the community, sponsored by Aglow, on the subject of Male/Female Reconciliation using Jane Hansen's book and material on this subject. (Alternative to regular monthly meeting - could use a "panel" to share different parts.)

Area Leadership Team do a workshop in the retreat setting on this subject.

For those with television access, discuss this subject on a Christian women's talk show-being fully prepared to share this message.

ISLAM MANDATE

SUGGESTED PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS

UPDATE:

In 1991, God spoke the prophetic word that we are to *pull the thread*. Immediately following our 2003 Aglow International Conference, God spoke prophetically again to the same woman who gave the thread word, stating:

I believe an impartation of release came in Indianapolis, the burka came off, and we will see increase in the nations. I also believe it is time for signs and wonders to begin to be released in our midst – particularly in the nations. . . One night (at Conference) I saw in the Spirit a woman who was veiled, and although she was veiled in black, underneath she was absolutely radiant – she was all light underneath the burka and she had a huge smile on her face and such joy that I could see that she was totally free.

The thread God has given to this ministry is so powerful that if we let the Lord open our eyes and respond to the opportunities He will give us— this word will come to pass . . .the garment will be unraveled and the veil torn. The light of Christ will come in.

If we will seize the moment, open our eyes and hear His heart, He will move. Each one of us has a specific place and each one of us will make a difference!

3. IDENTIFY

What are the Muslim cultural dynamics of your area or your nation?

- Be observant. Locate where they are mosques and Islamic schools in your area.
- Is there a community of Muslims, or a concentration of Muslim refugees?
- Are there places with signs in Arabic?
- Watch for newspaper articles in your local area.

4. ASSIST

- Work with the Islamic Awareness and Education Coordinator in your region (if one has been appointed), keeping your U.S. Director in the communication loop. A rrange speaking opportunities for her at a Lighthouse meeting, Area Retreat, Church, home group.
- Assist with the *Diwaniya for Women* television series (in Arabic) on Public Access
 Television where there are concentrations of Arabic speaking people. (Briefly explain this
 for those who are not familiar with the project)

5. REACH OUT

- Pray and ask the Lord for a Muslim friend.
- Several Aglow women in a U.S. city are associated with the local university. They have invited M uslim instructors and students over for tea and dessert. They told them, B ring pictures of your family. They have had precious times with them.
