1. Renewal means revitalization, rejuvenation, rebirth, restoration, or repair. Isaiah 43:19 and 2 Corinthians 5:17 speak of times of renewal. What does renewal mean to you personally or as an Aglow person?
2. When God calls us to a new level of anointing often that new place will bump into old mindsets that we developed in the old place. What is the first thought that comes into your mind when you hear that change is coming? Where do you think that thought originates?
3. Inward development is much more vital than external circumstances is an incredible statement. What does this mean to you? How could developing your inner man to be more like Christ – slow to anger – unconditional love – help you navigate external circumstances.
4. List external circumstances that you have allowed to challenge the peace of the inner man.
5. Graham said that if we only want our external circumstances to change, we will not develop the internal life – the abundant life – the life found in the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus – that Jesus died to give us. What does this mean to you?
6. Here are scriptures about the life Christ came to give us. Take the time to look them up and read aloud. Romans 8:2; Galatians 5:16; 2 Corinthians 5:17; 1 John 5:14; 2 Cor. 2:14

8. Aglow does walk under an apostolic anointing. That does not mean that we are apostles, it means that we have an anointing like an apostle does which enables us to take territory, start new works, disciple converts, and establish Ecclesia hubs in communities around the world. When you hear the words ‘apostolic anointing’, what does this mean to you? When you hear the words ‘Ecclesia hubs’, what does this mean to you.

9. Business as usual cannot produce real change in the world. What does this mean to you?
10. How important are young people to a new move of God? Does this mean that ‘old’ people no longer have a place?
11. What is a definition of crafted prayer? To learn more about Crafted Prayer, see Graham’s book Crafted Prayer. [Crafted Prayer – brilliant-book-house](#) to order a copy.

12. Graham lists several definitions of crafted prayer. Write down as many as you can find in the above paragraphs.
13. Read what Jesus said in John 10:10 about abundant life and who gives it. Graham is saying that even though there is a thief who comes to steal from us, kill us and to attempt to destroy us, we don't have to be moved by what we see rather, we must live out of the life Christ provides for us. Do you think that believers in Christ can live a life filled with victory on earth or is this victorious life only reserved for eternity in Heaven? Offer back up for what you think.
14. How familiar are you with previous messages spoken to Aglow? Do you know that messages back to 2004 are available on the aglow.org site? Check them out here: [Global Leader Development Resources - Aglow International](#) You can find many prophetic messages with prophetic words pulled out into separate documents for your convenience.
15. Are you aware of Aglow's YouTube channel? [Aglow International - YouTube](#) You can find full length messages, short clips, prophetic words, and many other topics. Make it a day of discovery. When you know who you are as a ministry, then you know how to stand in the world.
16. Graham said that Aglow needs more powerful developers of people with vision and purpose and who have new eyes to see who Aglow needs to become next. As you read that statement, what are your thoughts? Do inadequacies flood your mind? Slowly, let them all go.

Graham also said earlier that Aglow became a movement because of a heart cry that allowed God the freedom to draw us forward. Can you, will you step beyond all inadequacies and fears and let your whisper be, Lord, help me to be one of the powerful developers of people who have new eyes to see who Aglow needs to become next. I am willing. Help me, Holy Spirit.

17. In Asher Intrater's 2009 Conference message, he asked Aglow three questions. 1 - will you be the warriors, the Bride on this earth to invite those warrior angels back? 2 - will you be the spirit of Mary and birth Jesus back into this planet again? And 3 - will you accept this Joshua mandate to take possession of planet earth again? Take dominion over this earth and kick the devil out of here and bring Jesus back? Are you willing to do that? 2009-Asher-Intrater-Taking-Dominion.pdf Aglow has already answered this questions by saying YES! Like John who prepared the way of the Lord in the birth of the early Church, so does Aglow have a part in preparing people to be ready for the return of the Lord.

Talk amongst yourselves about how you think Aglow is accomplishing this in your community.

How are you reaching out to those who are not yet born again?

How are you discipling those who are born again?

18. A forerunner is one who goes before another preparing the way. What does it mean to you that Aglow is a forerunner ministry? How do you see what you present in Aglow in your community, region or state as preparing the way or preparing the people for something greater? It is not business as usual. Time is short.

19. As you think of the way you walk through each day, are you aware that you are living beneath the Shadow of the Almighty? What does that mean to you? Do you think that you are living in the fullness that God provided for you through Jesus? When God looks at you, He isn't looking at your behavior or places you think you have failed. He looks at your placement which is found in Christ. He only sees Christ in you and you in Christ. He has placed you in a position to succeed in all things. Ask Holy Spirit to open your eyes to the fullness of this marvelous truth.
20. Most of us have been hurt by another. Take a few moments and make the decision to let go of all hurt. Take a deep breath and say, "Father, I trust You. I let go of all those who have caused hurt and pain in the past. I forgive them now. Take my emotions and bring Glory for Your Kingdom forth as I walk forward from this place no longer tied to the past. Thank You for causing me to even forget that they hurt me. I receive healing now. Jesus, You make all things beautiful.
21. Graham called Jane the keeper of the prophetic keys and she was faithful to repeat them to us often. Talk amongst yourselves and bring to mind all the prophetic words you remember from the past. If you are new to Aglow, many conference messages back to 2004 are available on the Aglow website. [Global Leader Development Resources - Aglow International](#) Perhaps your group could choose one to glean prophetic promises from. These prophetic promises have to become as real in your heart as they are in God's heart. You can do this!
22. How can you develop your mindset so that you have the thoughts in your heart that you need going forward?
23. Graham has talked to us before about having evidence that you are changing more into the image of Christ. Take the time to share with others the transforming changes that you have seen in their lives. Listen closely as they share about you. Name a few places where you need to see more growth in the future.
24. Many of us will default to what we lack. Think about the words of life that have been spoken over you. God sees you one way. That is the place that He speaks to you from. He doesn't see lack. He sees all the ability that He wove into your DNA. Believe what He has said to you and promised to you. Step out in see those truths developed in you. If He has told you that you are a warrior, what are some ways that you could begin to develop warrior qualities within yourself?
25. Development is key in the Kingdom. When God gives you an assignment, He also will provide the means for you to complete the assignment. One of the things Graham says in the next paragraph is that there comes a time when we should stop asking God over and over for the same thing – as though He isn't providing – and to begin to thank Him before you receive it because you believe that the provision will arrive right on time. Talk amongst yourselves about trusting God to provide for the assignments He has given to you. Do you have mindsets that need to shift? If so, talk about how to move to a new place in believing God and taking Him at His word. Take a few minutes to begin to thank God for things that you have been asking for, for years.

26. Graham says that when our heart is fixed on love, our mind can be set on purpose. Take a few minutes to talk about what that means to you.

Colossians 3:2 “Set your mind on things above, not on earthly things.”

Matthew 22:37 “Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.”

I John 4:8,16; Phil 4:18

27. Graham is telling us that when we have a key scripture (inheritance scripture, life verse, etc.) or a prophetic promise, that we are to set our focus on the promised because God said it and it cannot fail when we follow the process, and let the mind of Christ take us to the place of receiving what God has promised.

Take some time and make a list of promises or prophetic words that have yet to be fulfilled in your life. Read Habakkuk 2:3 and talk about how this relates to what Graham is saying.

28. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says “Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.” NIV As Graham has said that giving thanks for all God is doing can open up a deeper level of receiving for you personally and in your Aglow group. What does it mean to you to give thanks in all circumstances?

In Philippians 4:11-13 the apostle Paul says that he has learned to be content whatever the circumstance. In verse 12, NIV, he says that he has learned the secret of being content. Then he reveals what gives him the ability to be content. Look up this passage of scripture and read aloud vs 13.

Stop and pray, asking God that this same mind that was in Paul be formed in you as you walk through each day of your life.

29. Here are some scriptures on praise. Psalm 150:1-6; Psalm 100:1-5; Psalm 103:1; Psalm 95:1-3; Psalm 63:3-6; Acts 16:25-26; Isaiah 25:1; Psalm 28:7; Psalm 9:1; Psalm 145:3; Psalm 42:11; Psalm 34:1; Psalm 139:13-14; Revelation 5:13; Psalm 71:8; Colossians 3:16; Jeremiah 17:14; Isaiah 12:4; Psalm 108:3; Ephesians 1:3; Acts 2:46-47; Psalm 66:17

Take time to read each one slowly aloud and watch as the power of praise released by His Word changes the atmosphere in the room. Consider reading these scriptures in your gatherings and daily in your home.

30. What did Graham say that is the only thing that can challenge us?

31. What has the power to overcome any negativity?

Do you think that complaining about your circumstances are helpful in any way?

Do you think that it is possible that complaining could be blocking the good things God has stored up for you and wants to release to you?

32. How important is the Goodness of God in your life? Do you possibly need an upgrade in your thinking about God's Goodness and its place in your life? Take a minute to reflect and perhaps have a talk with God about this.
33. "If you meet an accusation with an accusation of your own – you are doing the work of the accuser, too." Think about that statement. There is something within the soul of mankind that wants to be right, to defend itself, to even have its way. However, as God's people, we live from a higher place. Now might be a good time to repent and ask Holy Spirit to give you a new way of thinking so that your responses come from your born-again spirit rather than the soulish area of the old man that Jesus died to kill. No condemnation at all.
34. Take a moment to write out Romans 12:21. What does Graham say is the source of real power for us?
35. How are you walking in the Goodness of who God is in your family? In your Community? Towards those who do not believe like you believe?
36. As we begin to walk more fully into Goodness being a way of life, Graham has prophesied that there will be evidence happening around us. List some of them.
37. Jesus overcame evil with Good every day of His life. The blind saw, the dead were raised. Years ago, Graham asked this question: What if the only thing missing in America (and the nations of the world) is the Goodness of God?
- As you have read though half of this prophetic word, can you see how Goodness must come to the forefront as you go about the assignments God has given to your group in your community?
- Can you see that living out of the Goodness of God will bring the provision needed to do complete the assignments God has given into your hands to do?
38. Graham said that Goodness is the only visible expression of the Kingdom in our midst. Selah.
- What about Love, you might ask? The two go together and cannot be separated. God is both Good and He is Love. You cannot piece mill out who God is. It is all interconnected and where Goodness abounds, so does Love. So does Joy. So does Peace. So does provision. So does healing.
- Do you feel that you are beginning to see or understand something that you possible haven't considered before this prophetic word was given?
39. What if everything you thought you knew about being a Christian in this world has just been turned upside down by the simple understand of the power contained by the Goodness of God? Take time to share your thoughts, or if you are alone, journal them.
40. Thinking about your reactions to situation in the past, can you see that it wasn't an evil spirit in someone that was challenging you, it was the Goodness of God within you, calling out to you to continue to move in Goodness? Why? Because if Jesus, and He did, moved in Goodness to overcome evil, so can you! Read that again. Read it out loud. Make it a personal statement now. In every trying situation, I CAN overcome evil with God's Goodness that lives inside of

me! Go ahead, say it in your own words. Do you feel a real sense of freedom, authority, and power rising within you?

41. As a citizen of Heaven, you can become partners of God's Goodness. Talk amongst yourselves about how this will shift what you are doing in your gatherings? How will it shift how you walk out your assignments?
42. Read 1 Peter 3:13-15 with the new lens you have been receiving through the revelation in this prophetic word. How does it challenge you to live out the rest of your days walking and releasing the Goodness of God to all those around you?
43. Graham is saying to us, Aglow, if we will purpose to align, to partner, to live from God's Goodness, not only will Aglow be lifted to a higher place, but so will all those who come in contact with us. We are becoming those people spoken of in Acts 17:6 But when they did not find them, they dragged Jason and some brethren to the rulers of the city, crying out, "These who have turned the world upside down have come here too."

Determine together to live from Goodness in all that is done going forth in your group.

44. Graham spoke an entire message about Aglow becoming a visual aid back in 2008. Graham Cooke Things that Graham said in 2008 will become revelation as you go through this message again. (The message is about God's dream of the Church and how Aglow has part in that dream.)
45. Go ahead and let those preceding two paragraphs sink in. This is the future of Aglow. And it is possible because God has said it is how He sees us.
